Responsibilities of computer recipient

- 1. Have clear desk space for the computer, monitor, keyboard, mouse, and speaker
- 2. Locate close to power outlets and recommend at least a 5 position power surge protector (Electrical connections for monitor, computer, speakers, modem and possible future printer)
- 3. Locate close to either the phone line for dial-up or modem for DSL or Cable
- 4. If connection to dial-up, have a disk purchased for installation (Best Buy or Wal-Mart)
- 5. If using DSL or Cable, have the modem previously installed
- 6. Dial-Up (\$15 \$25 per month) (Disks available at Best Buy and Wal-Mart)
- 7. Local DSL companies are Qwest (\$30 \$60 per month)
- 8. Local Cable companies are Wave Broadband and Comcast (\$45- \$60 per month) (Comcast Essentials Program for low income with school-aged children costs \$9.95 per month)
- 9. Keep liquids away from the computer and the keyboard.
- 10. Practice good computer 'housekeeping' practices, i.e., anti-virus, malware, CCleaner, Patch my PC, etc. Help keep your computer running efficiently and avoid being hacked!
- 11. This computer is provided for your use and your school aged children's use only.

Responsibilities of KCS New Horizons Personnel

- 1. Provide computer, monitor, keyboard, mouse, and speakers (laptop systems will only be provided an external mouse
- 2. Explain connection of electrical, monitor, mouse, keyboard and speaker cables
- 3. Turn on and verify computer is in working order
- 4. If disk for dial-up has been previously purchased will install
- 5. If DSL or Cable connect Ethernet cable connection will be explained
- 6. Provide information on installed programs and their use

- 1. Windows 7 or 10 operating system with all of the latest Microsoft updates.
- 2. Computer has connections required for DSL or Cable
- 3. If requesting Phone Dial-Up please specify because NOT all computers have a dial-up modem!!!
- 4. A working speaker system with external speakers some require an electrical connection (desktop systems only)
- 5. Free and up-to-date Anti-Virus program
- 6. A defragmenting (Smart Defragmenter) program and a temporary file cleaning program (CCleaner)
- 7. Internet support programs (Adobe Reader, Java, Adobe Flash Player)
- 8. A built-in CD or DVD player for music movies etc.
